I. Summary:

This legislation re-creates the Florida Organ and Tissue Donor Education and Procurement Trust Fund within the Agency for Health Care Administration.

This bill re-creates section 732.92155, Florida Statutes.

II. Present Situation:

The purpose of the Florida Organ and Tissue Donor Education and Procurement Trust Fund is to maintain the organ and tissue donor registry and the organ and tissue donor education. This trust fund was created by chapter 95-316, Laws of Florida, as the Florida Organ and Tissue Donor Education Trust Fund, and is scheduled to terminate on July 1, 1999.

The Florida Organ and Tissue Donor Education Trust Fund was redesignated as the Florida Organ and Tissue Donor Education and Procurement Trust Fund by chapter 96-418, Laws of Florida. The trust funds in the Agency for Health Care Administration are scheduled for review by the Legislature in Fiscal Year 2000.

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
