serve each elementary school must plan and coordinate 1 2 activities within the feeder pattern for that school. 3 (2) Private preschool and kindergarten providers must 4 be invited to participate. 5 (3) The program must provide an orientation program 6 for children at each ascending level, from preschool and child 7 care programs to kindergarten and from kindergarten to first 8 grade. (4) A method for data exchange among programs and 9 10 schools at the different levels must be established. 11 (5) There must be joint planning and staff development 12 of service providers, including public schools, for the activities of the program. 13 14 (6) Providers of kindergarten and first grade programs 15 must agree on goals and strategies that create a smooth transition for children from the playful orientation of 16 17 kindergarten to the more structured activities of first grade. Section 4.
