Legislature finds that, pursuant to a study conducted by the 14 15 Department of State and the Office of the Mayor of the City of Hialeah, it is in the best interest of the public that Hialeah 16 17 Park, located in Hialeah, Florida, be owned by the state or a 18 municipality in order to conserve the acreage of the park and 19 preserve its historical and recreational significance. 20 Section 2. Section 550.72, Florida Statutes, as created by section 12 of chapter 98-190, Laws of Florida, is 21 22 repealed. 23 Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 24 law. 25 26 27 SENATE SUMMARY Provides that, pursuant to a study conducted by the Department of State and the Office of the Mayor of the City of Hialeah, it is in the public's best interest that Hialeah Park be owned by the state or a municipality.
