The facts stated in the preamble to this 24 25 act are found and declared to be true. Section 2. The sum of \$45,000 is appropriated out of 26 27 funds in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of 28 Business and Professional Regulation to be paid to the Wewahitchka State Bank for the loss of its security interest 29 30 in Liquor License No. 33-00032. 31 1

2	warrant in favor of the Wewahitchka State Bank in the sum of
3	\$45,000 upon funds in the State Treasury to the credit of the

6	funds.
7	Section 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
8	law.
