- (3) At least 40 percent of the total appropriation for loans, subsidies, grants, demonstration projects, and direct assistance for the first year of the programs shall be used for mobile homes, including programs to inspect and improve tie-downs, construct and provide safety structures, and provide other means to reduce losses. In the second year of the programs, at least 30 percent of the total appropriation shall be used for mobile homes, and thereafter at least 20 percent shall be used for such purposes.
- (4) The Department of Community Affairs shall develop the programs in consultation with an advisory council appointed by the secretary consisting of a representative of the Department of Insurance, a representative of home builders, a representative of insurance companies, a representative of the Federation of Mobile Home Owners, a representative of the Florida Association of Counties, and a representative of the Florida Manufactured Housing Association who is a mobile home manufacturer or supplier.
- (5) Moneys provided to the Department of Community

 Affairs under this section are intended to supplement other

 funding sources of the Department of Community Affairs and may

 not supplant other funding sources of the Department of

 Community Affairs.
- (6) On January 1st of 2001 and 2002, the Department of Community Affairs shall provide a full report and accounting of activities under this section and an evaluation of such
