Section 316.2126, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 20 316.2126 Use of golf/utility golf carts by certain 21 22 municipalities .-- In addition to the powers granted by ss. 23 316.212 and 316.2125, municipalities older than 400 years old 24 are hereby authorized to utilize golf/utility golf carts, as 25 defined in s. 320.01, upon any state, county, or municipal roads located within the corporate limits of such 26 27 municipalities, subject to the following conditions: 28 (1) Golf/utility Golf carts operated beyond the 29 authority granted in ss. 316.212 and 316.2125 may only be 30 operated by municipal employees for municipal purposes, 31

including, but not limited to, police patrol, traffic 2 enforcement, and inspection of public facilities. 3 (2) In addition to the safety equipment required in s. 4 316.212(6), such golf/utility golf carts must be equipped with 5 sufficient lighting and turn signal equipment. 6 The golf/utility golf carts may only be operated 7 on state roads that have a posted speed limit of 30 miles per 8 hour or less. 9 Section 2.
