II. Summary of Amendments Contained in Message

House Amendment 1 corrects court case in WHEREAS language.

House Amendment 2 inserts “knowingly” regarding possession or receipt of infected or infested plan material.

House Amendment 3 removes reference to 1.900 foot radius.

House Amendment 4 removes risk assessment language.

House Amendment 5 is to prevent soil and water contamination, provides that decontamination rules be developed in consultation with DEP.

House Amendment 6 requires owners/operators of non-production vehicles and equipment to follow DACS’ guidelines for decontamination.

House Amendment 7 provides waiver of liability for costs or damages associated with any soil and water contamination resulting from citrus canker decontamination program.

House Amendment 8 is the substance of General Agriculture bill, HB 2237 which is in Senate and SB 1904, which is on the Special Order Calendar.
