## I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Social Services Block Grant Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2000. The Social Services Block Grant Trust Fund, FLAIR #64-2-639, is administered by the Department of Health. This fund was created effective July 1,1997, by Chapter 97-112, Laws of Florida.

### II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

#### A. PRESENT SITUATION:

#### 1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Section 20.435, F.S., creates the trust fund, provides revenue sources for the fund, and defines the uses of the fund.

## 2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The fund tracks receipts and expenditures of federal Social Security Block Grant Funds used to support health and social services.

# 3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The major sources of revenue for the fund are federal Social Services Block Grant funds. According to Comptroller data, receipts to this fund for FY 1998-99 were \$9,578,656.28.

#### B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
