I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Historic Pensacola Preservation Board Operating Trust Fund, effective November 4, 2000, without modification. The Historic Pensacola Preservation Board Operating Trust Fund, FLAIR #45-2-510, is administered by the Department of State. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 1996, by Chapter 96-76, Laws of Florida.

II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

No reference in statutes.

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The fund is used to fund salaries, operating expenses, and the acquisition and operation of properties.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The major sources of revenue for the fund are proceeds from the sale of property that is owned or controlled by a board, or its direct-support organization. According to Comptroller data, receipts to this fund for FY 1998-99 were \$4,995.

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
