A bill to be entitled
An act relating to Islamorada, Village of
Islands, Monroe County; authorizing the village
to exercise its police powers and jurisdiction
extending 1,200 feet into the tidal waters
adjacent to its established corporate limits;
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Islamorada, Village of Islands, Monroe
County, is authorized to exercise its police powers and
jurisdiction 1,200 feet into the tidal waters adjacent to its
established corporate limits; however, the exercise of such
police powers and jurisdiction beyond the corporate limits of
the village shall extend only to the abatement of nuisances,
the enforcement of sanitary laws and regulations, the
regulation of zoning, and the suppression of crime.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.
