(1) The Division of State Lands of the Department of 6 7 Environmental Protection may acquire in the name of the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund any 8 additional property adjacent or contiguous to the Rodman 9 10 Reservoir Recreation Area, from private owners or from the 11 United States Government for improved management and 12 recreational opportunities.
