Such 16 17 software must be installed and maintained on at least one-half 18 of the library's computers that are available for public use, 19 and, if the library makes only one computer available for 20 public use, such software must be installed and maintained on 21 that computer. 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2000. 23 24 25 SENATE SUMMARY Requires each public library that allows public access to on-line computer services to install and maintain 26 computer software that prohibits access to obscene materials.
