The Secretary of Barbecue shall be a ceremonial position. 14 The secretary shall serve without compensation. 15 16 (2) The Secretary of Barbecue, or the secretary's 17 designee, shall represent the Governor in functions promoting the enjoyment of barbecue and shall promote the diversity of 18 barbecue created by the many cultures represented in the 19 20 state's diverse citizenry.
