The hospital report 24 25 cards must be made available to the public through the Internet and other commonly used means of distribution no 26 27 later than July 1 of each year. The hospital report cards must 28 be organized by county and, at a minimum, present an itemized 29 list showing for each hospital in the state summarize: 30 The name and address of the hospital. 31
