hardship on the farm operation; (b) Alternative state or federal regulations, including implementation of Best Management Practices, substantially achieve the objective of the local regulation; (c) The impact of the farm activity on adjacent land uses, if any, may be substantially mitigated by implementation of alternative measures; and (d) Issuance of the waiver or variance will not be detrimental to the public health, welfare, and safety; will not create a nuisance; and will not materially increase the level of pollution from the subject activity.
