This performance shall 18 19 be known as the "Retired Jai Alai Players Charity Day." The 20 administration of this fund shall be determined by rule by the division. 21 22 (9) Notwithstanding the limitations set forth in 23 subsection (8), any jai alai permitholder who has not conducted one "Retired Jai Alai Players Charity Day" 24 25 performance per year since the 1992-1993 fiscal year is 26 authorized to conduct up to two performances per fiscal year 27 until the time when the total number of such performances is 28 equivalent to the total number of fiscal years. This subsection shall be repealed on July 1, 2000. 29 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000. 31
