A 1 2 minimum of 50 percent of the total funds provided over the 3 life of the Florida Forever program pursuant to this paragraph 4 shall be used for the acquisition of lands. 5 (b) Thirty-five percent to the Department of 6 Environmental Protection for the acquisition of lands and 7 capital project expenditures described in this section, of 8 which amount \$25 million shall be transferred by the Department of Environmental Protection into the Save Our 9 10 Everglades Trust Fund. Of the proceeds distributed pursuant to this paragraph, it is the intent of the Legislature that an 11 12 increased priority be given to those acquisitions which 13 achieve a combination of conservation goals, including protecting Florida's water resources and natural groundwater 14 15 recharge.
