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Senator Sullivan moved the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 7, between lines 27 and 28,

insert:

(9) ANNUAL REPORT.--The Board of Regents, the Executive Office of the Governor, the Department of Health, and the Agency for Health Care Administration shall collaborate to establish a committee that shall produce an annual report on graduate medical education. To the maximum extent feasible, the committee shall have the same membership as the Graduate Medical Education Study Committee, established by the proviso accompanying Specific Appropriation 191 of the fiscal year 1999-2000 General Appropriations Act. The report shall be provided to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by January 15 of each year. Committee members shall serve without compensation. From the funds provided in s. 381.0403(3), the committee may expend a maximum of \$75,000 per year to provide for administrative costs and contractual services. The report

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1 must address the following topics:

2 (a) The role of residents and medical faculty in the  
3 provision of health care.

4 (b) The relationship of graduate medical education to  
5 the state's physician workforce.

6 (c) The costs of training medical residents for  
7 hospitals, medical schools, teaching hospitals, including all  
8 hospital-medical affiliations, practice plans at all of the  
9 medical schools, and municipalities.

10 (d) The availability and adequacy of all sources of  
11 revenue to support graduate medical education. The report must  
12 also recommend alternative sources of funding for graduate  
13 medical education.

14 (e) The use of state and federal appropriated funds  
15 for graduate medical education by hospitals receiving such  
16 funds.
