9	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

11	Section 1. The Department of Management Services, in
12	cooperation with the Florida School for the Deaf and the
13	Blind, shall develop and implement a specialized training
14	program for career service, nonteaching employees who deal
15	with visually impaired and hearing impaired students. The
16	program shall include a revised classification and pay grade
17	component that will permit retention and recruitment of
18	employees with special skills. The department and the school
19	shall provide a report and recommendation by January 1, 2001.
20	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000.

22	STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN
23	COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR Senate Bill 2572

25	The Committee Substitute replaces the provisions of the filed
26	bill with a requirement that the Department of Management Services and the School for the Deaf and Blind issue a report
27	and recommendation on a revised classification and pay plan for employees who deal with visually and hearing impaired
