The Operating Trust Fund, FLAIR #52-2-510, is administered by the Department of Community Affairs (DCA). This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 1996, by Chapter 96-18, Laws of Florida.

The fund is used to provide financial assistance to DCA is administering the "Uniform Special District Accountability Acta of 1989" in accordance with s. 189.427, F.S.; in coordinating and administering the "Florida Hazardous Materials Emergency Response and Community Right-to-Know Act of 1988" in accordance with s. 252.82, F.S., and; in appropriating sums necessary and required by the state for grant matching, implementing, administering, evaluating, and qualifying for federal funds under the provisions of s. 943.25, F.S.
