Subsection (5) is added to section 15 16 236.08106, Florida Statutes, to read: 236.08106 Excellent Teaching Program. --17 (5)(a) Each school district that contains a school in 18 19 grade category "F" shall develop a plan to encourage teachers 20 with demonstrated mastery in improving student performance to 21 remain at or transfer to that school. If a teacher whose 22 mastery has been formally recognized by the designation of 23 Teacher of the Year at the district or state level, or who is certified by the National Board of Professional Teaching 24 25 Standards, requests assignment to a school with grade category "F," the school board and the principal shall make every 26 27 practical effort to grant the request. 2.8 (b) Effective July 1, 2000, a teacher who has attained 29 NBPTS certification or who has been designated district or 30 state Teacher of the Year is eligible for a bonus if he or she 31

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1 is assigned to teach at a failing school. This bonus in addition to any bonus received because of NBPTS certification. 2 3 (c) The State Board of Education may specify 4 additional criteria for identifying teachers who are 5 ineligible under paragraph (b) but who otherwise demonstrate б mastery. Effective July 1, 2001, a teacher identified under this paragraph is eligible for a bonus if he or she transfers 7 to a failing school or is teaching at such a school at the 8 time mastery is determined. The Commissioner of Education 9 10 shall adopt rules prescribing the measures used to determine the teaching mastery necessary to become eligible for a bonus 11 12 under this paragraph. (d) A teacher identified under this subsection and 13 assigned to a failing school is eligible for an annual bonus 14 15 for a maximum of 5 years at that school. If the teacher then transfers to another failing school, he or she may earn a 16 bonus for an additional 5 years. 17 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 19 law. 20 21 22 SENATE SUMMARY Provides for school districts to permit schools in grade category "F" to relocate certain teachers. Authorizes the State Board of Education to identify additional qualifications of demonstrated mastery for teachers.
