The escrow account will be maintained by the 20 Department of Transportation for the benefit of the Department 21 of Environmental Protection and the water management 22 23 districts. Any interest earnings from the escrow account shall remain with the Department of Transportation. 24 The Department of Environmental Protection or water management 25 26 districts may request a transfer of funds from the escrow 27 account no sooner than 30 days prior to the date the funds are needed to pay for activities associated with development or 28 29 implementation of the approved mitigation plan described in subsection (4) for the current fiscal year, including, but not 30

Actual conceptual plan preparation costs incurred 1 2 before plan approval may be submitted to the Department of 3 Transportation and the Department of Environmental Protection 4 by November 1 of each year with the plan. The conceptual plan 5 preparation costs of each water management district will be 6 paid based on the amount approved on the mitigation plan and 7 allocated to the current fiscal year projects identified by 8 the water management district. The amount transferred to the 9 escrow account each year by the Department of Transportation shall correspond to a cost per acre of \$75,000 multiplied by 10 the projected acres of impact identified in the inventory 11 12 described in subsection (2). However, the \$75,000 cost per 13 acre does not constitute an admission against interest by the 14 state or its subdivisions nor is the cost admissible as 15 evidence of full compensation for any property acquired by eminent domain or through inverse condemnation. Each July 1, 16 17 the cost per acre shall be adjusted by the percentage change 18 in the average of the Consumer Price Index issued by the 19 United States Department of Labor for the most recent 12-month period ending September 30, compared to the base year average, 20 which is the average for the 12-month period ending September 21 30, 1996. At the end of each year, the projected acreage of 22 23 impact shall be reconciled with the acreage of impact of projects as permitted, including permit modifications, 24 pursuant to this part and s. 404 of the Clean Water Act, 33 25 26 U.S.C. s. 1344. The subject year's transfer of funds shall be adjusted accordingly to reflect the overtransfer or 27 undertransfer of funds from the preceding year. The Department 28 29 of Transportation is authorized to transfer such funds from 30 the escrow account to the Department of Environmental 31
