## I. Summary:

This legislation re-creates the Executive Branch Lobby Registration Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2000. The Executive Branch Lobby Registration Trust Fund, FLAIR #11-2-203, is administered by the legislative branch. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 1996, by Chapter 96-85, Laws of Florida.

This bill re-creates section 112.3215, Florida Statutes.

The fund is used for the purpose of funding any office established to administer the registration of lobbyists lobbying an agency, including the payment of salaries and other expenses.
