Section 421.101, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 20 421.101 False representations to obtain lower rent in 21 22 housing accommodations; penalty. --Whoever makes a false statement or representation, knowing it to be false, or 23 24 knowingly fails to disclose a material fact in order to obtain 25 a lower rent for housing accommodations in a low-rent housing development operated pursuant to this chapter, than the rental 26 27 such person is required to pay pursuant to federal or state 28 statutes, schedule of rents or rules and regulations as 29 determined and fixed by housing authorities created pursuant to this chapter, commits aforesaid, shall be guilty of a 30 31 felony misdemeanor of the third second degree, punishable as 2

Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000. б SENATE SUMMARY Includes public housing assistance in the definition of public assistance for the purposes of fraud. Increases the criminal penalty for false representations in obtaining lower rent in specified housing accommodations.
