6. A lobbyist, a lobbyist's legal representative, or the principal of a lobbyist may request relief from any provision relating to the filing of an expenditure report based on unusual circumstances. Such request, which must be filed under oath with the General Counsel of the Office of Legislative Services, must state the relief sought and good cause for such relief to be granted. The General Counsel of the Office of Legislative Services shall review the request and make a recommendation to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives may grant or deny the request or may award some lesser or other relief than that sought.
