## II. Summary of Amendments Contained in Message

**House Amendment 1** eliminates the district pre-adoption process, while requiring balanced geographical representation on the existing state committee.

## The amendment also:

Specifies the teacher composition of the state committee;

Provides the commissioner with additional responsibilities for pilot programs and contracts;

Requires a pilot program for customizing materials;

Provides additional protections for the accuracy of materials;

Provides a safeguard for keeping the costs of materials in line with district allocations;

Clarifies the newly created components of the best financial management practices review; and

Updates several notice requirements related to the adoption and selection process.
