29 30 the highest number of votes in excess of 40 percent of the votes cast shall be declared nominated. If four or more candidates appear on the ballot for nomination to a particular office, the candidate receiving the highest number of votes in excess of 33-1/3 percent of the votes cast shall be declared nominated. Each candidate receiving a majority of the votes cast in each contest in the first primary election shall be declared nominated for such office. A second primary election shall be held as provided by s. 100.091 in every contest in which a candidate does not receive the necessary number of votes for nomination a majority.

Section 66. Effective upon this act becoming a law, subsection (2) of section 100.091, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

100.091 Second primary election. --

- (2) The names of the candidates placing first and second in the first primary election shall be placed on the ballot in the second primary election for each contest in which no candidate receives the necessary number a majority of the votes cast in the first primary election, subject to the following exceptions:
- (a) In any contest in which there is a tie for first place in the first primary election, only the names of the candidates so tying shall be placed on the ballot in the second primary election.
- (b) In any contest in which there is a tie for second place in the first primary election and the candidate placing first did not receive the necessary number a majority of the votes cast, the name of the candidate placing first and the names of the candidates tying for second shall be placed on 31 the ballot in the second primary election.
