Section 25. Subsection (10) is added to section 255.05, Florida Statutes, to read:

255.05 Bond of contractor constructing public buildings; form; action by materialmen.--

(10) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, no county, city, or political subdivision, or other public authority, shall require a contractor to accept, or penalize a contractor for not accepting, as a condition of any contract to which this section applies, insurance coverage through an owner-controlled insurance plan in which the public authority or its agent obtains insurance coverage for contractors and subcontractors relative to a construction project or group of related construction projects, including worker's compensation, employer's liability, general liability, or builder's risk insurance.
