A bill to be entitled An act relating to sale or transfer of firearms at gun shows; amending s. 790.001, F.S.; defining "gun show," "gun show promoter," and "qun show vendor"; creating s. 790.0653, F.S.; prohibiting the sale or transfer of a firearm by a gun show vendor at a gun show unless a criminal history background check of the prospective transferee has been conducted; requiring approval of the transfer from the Department of Law Enforcement; providing a third degree felony penalty for violation; providing a third degree felony penalty for the willful and knowing provision of false identification or fraudulent information relative to the sale or transfer of a firearm at a gun show; requiring licensed gun dealers conducting criminal history background checks at gun shows to record the transfer of a firearm and retain records as otherwise required by law; requiring gun show promoters to arrange for the services of one or more licensed gun dealers to be on the premises of a gun show for the purpose of obtaining background checks; requiring posting of specified notice at gun shows; providing a first degree misdemeanor penalty for failure to post such notice; exempting antique firearms from the requirements of the act; authorizing licensed gun dealers to charge a fee for

1 (1) A gun show vendor may not sell or transfer a firearm at a gun show, or attempt to sell or transfer a 2 3 firearm at a gun show, unless the the gun show vendor has: Obtained a completed form from the potential buyer 4 5 or transferee required by s. 790.065(1)(a). 6 (b) Collected a fee from the potential buyer for 7 processing the criminal history background check of the 8 potential buyer. The fee shall be established by the Department of Law Enforcement and may not exceed \$10 per 9 transaction. - (b) Any individual who gives false information in connection with the making of such records commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
- (3) A gun show promoter shall arrange for the services of one or more licensed gun dealers to be on the premises of any gun show conducted or operated by the promoter for the purpose of obtaining the background checks required by this section.
- (4)(a) A gun show promoter shall conspicuously post a notice, in a form to be prescribed by the Department of Law Enforcement, setting forth the requirement for completion of a background check as provided in this section.
- (b) Any gun show promoter who fails to post or conspicuously display the notice required under paragraph (a) at any gun show conducted by the gun show promoter commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
- (5) The provisions of this section shall not apply to the transfer of an antique firearm, as defined in s. 790.001(1).
- (6) Any licensed dealer, gun show vendor, or gun show promoter who violates the provisions of subsection (1) commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
- (7) Any potential buyer or transferee who willfully and knowingly provides false information or fraudulent identification with respect to the sale or transfer, or attempted sale or transfer, of any weapon or firearm at a gun show commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.

Section 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 2001. HOUSE SUMMARY Requires gun show vendors to conduct background checks and obtain approval from the Department of Law Enforcement prior to the sale or transfer of a firearm at a gun show. Provides a third degree felony penalty for violation. Provides a third degree felony penalty for the willful and knowing provision of false identification or fraudulent information relative to the sale or transfer of a firearm at a gun show. Requires recording of firearms sales and transfers at gun shows and retention of records as required by law. Requires gun show promoters to arrange for the services of one or more licensed gun dealers to be on the premises of any gun show for the purpose of obtaining background checks. Authorizes licensed gun dealers to charge a \$10 fee for conducting background checks at gun shows.
