A bill to be entitled
An act relating to the Partnership for Quality
Medical and Dental Education; establishing the
Partnership for Quality Medical and Dental
Education pilot project between Florida
Agricultural and Mechanical University, the
University of Florida, and the University of

medical and dental education; providing program
requirements; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Partnership for Quality Medical and Dental Education pilot project.—For the purpose of increasing the participation of underrepresented groups, such as economically disadvantaged youth and minority students, in the fields of medical and dental education, a partnership pilot project is hereby created between the undergraduate science programs at Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University and the graduate medical and dental programs at the University of Florida and the University of South Florida. The project shall provide the following for Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University students participating in the pilot project:

(1) Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University will be responsible for providing students enrolled in the first 2 years of the program with education in the basic sciences that corresponds with those courses required of students enrolled in the medical and dental programs at the University of Florida and the University of South Florida.

4	of intensive clinical training.
5	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.
