In addition, the member's 22 duties and responsibilities must include the pursuit, 23 apprehension, and arrest of law violators or suspected law 24 violators; or the member must be an active member of a bomb disposal unit whose primary responsibility is the location, 25 handling, and disposal of explosive devices; or the member 26 27 must be the supervisor or command officer of a member or 28 members who have such responsibilities; provided, however, 29 administrative support personnel, including, but not limited 30 to, those whose primary duties and responsibilities are in 31
