9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

10

11           Section 1. Subsections (3) and (4) of section 316.192,  
12 Florida Statutes, are renumbered as subsections (4) and (5),  
13 respectively, subsection (2) is amended, and a new subsection  
14 (3) is added to said section, to read:

316.192 Reckless driving.--

16

(2) Except as provided in subsection (3), any person  
17 convicted of reckless driving shall be punished:

18

(a) Upon a first conviction, by imprisonment for a  
19 period of not more than 90 days or by fine of not less than  
20 \$25 nor more than \$500, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

(b) On a second or subsequent conviction, by  
22 imprisonment for not more than 6 months or by a fine of not  
23 less than \$50 nor more than \$1,000, or by both such fine and  
24 imprisonment. In addition, if the person's reckless driving  
25 causes or results in the death of another, the person may  
26 serve 120 community hours as provided in s. 316.027(4).
