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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. The Department of Children and Family Services shall establish and maintain a central database to record and compile all district information relating to violations, citations, and penalties imposed against child care facilities regulated by the department. The database shall be operated in a manner that enables the department to identify and locate such information for purposes of monitoring and evaluating the uniformity and effectiveness of district investigations and enforcement, in order to ensure compliance of child care facilities with state regulatory requirements. The database shall further maintain and produce aggregate statistical reports monitoring patterns of violations, citations, and penalties, including the classes and types of violations, and any actions taken to suspend or revoke the license of a child care facility. The information in the database shall serve as a resource for the evaluation of child care facilities for license renewal but may not be used for employment screening. The information in the database shall be made available to the public upon request.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. HOUSE SUMMARY Requires the Department of Children and Family Services to establish and maintain a database to monitor violations, citations, and penalties imposed against child care facilities regulated by the state. Specifies certain capabilities of the database and uses of the information contained therein.
