An act relating to public records; providing an exemption from the public records law for information that identifies the claimant or case number in certain proceedings involving a nursing home or assisted living facility and that is provided to the Agency for Health Care Administration as required by law; providing an exemption from the public-records law for reports of liability claims involving nursing homes that are provided to the Agency for Health Care Administration as required by law; providing a finding of public necessity;

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

providing a contingent effective date.

Section 1. Any portion of a document identifying the claimant or case number of a claim or civil action that results in a final judgment, arbitration decision, order, injunction, mediation agreement, or settlement that involves a nursing home or assisted living facility and that is provided to the Agency for Health Care Administration as required under section 400.023(7) or section 400.429(8), Florida Statutes, is confidential and exempt from section 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and Section 24(a) of Article I of the State Constitution. This exemption is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995 in accordance with section 119.15, Florida Statutes, and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2006, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.

1 Section 2. The information contained in any report of liability claims against nursing homes provided to the Agency 2 3 for Health Care Administration as required under section 400.147(9), Florida Statutes, is confidential and exempt from 4 5 section 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and Section 24(a) of 6 Article I of the State Constitution. This exemption is subject 7 to the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995 in accordance 8 with section 119.15, Florida Statutes, and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2006, unless reviewed and saved from 9 10 repeal through reenactment by the Legislature. 11 Section 3. The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity to protect the identity of those persons who may 12 have received compensation pursuant to arbitration, mediation, 13 or litigation involving a nursing home or assisted living 14 15 facility. The Legislature finds that it is not in the best interest of potentially vulnerable individuals for such 16 17 information to be readily available to those who might use the information to take advantage of or prey upon such 18 19 individuals. Accordingly, the Legislature finds that the harm 20 to the public which would result from the release of such information substantially outweighs any minimal public benefit 21 derived therefrom. The Legislature also finds that monthly 22 reports of liability claims against nursing homes which are 23 24 provided to the Agency for Health care Administration contain 25 preliminary allegations that may not possess merit. Accordingly, the Legislature finds that the harm to nursing 26 27 homes due to the release of such preliminary information 28 substantially outweighs any minimal public benefit derived 29 therefrom. 30 Section 4. The bill is further amended to provide legislative intent for making reports of liability claims against nursing homes exempt from the Public Records Law.
