Vote and have his or her vote accurately counted. 19 2. Cast a vote if he or she is in line when the polls 20 are closing. Ask for and receive assistance in voting. 21 3. 22 A replacement ballot if he or she has voted in 4. 23 error. 5. An explanation if his or her registration is in 24 25 question. 6. If his or her registration is in question, cast a 26 27 provisional ballot. 7. Prove his or her identity by signing an affidavit 28 29 if election officials doubt the voter's identity. 30 8. Written instructions to use when voting, and, upon request, oral instructions in voting from elections officers. 31 1

9. Vote free from coercion or intimidation by elections officers or any other person. 10. Vote on a voting machine that is in working condition and that will allow votes to be accurately cast. The supervisor of elections shall have the Voter's (2) Bill of Rights [printed in a large font and in English and where applicable in Spanish and Creole] and make it available at each polling place in the form of a handbill so that voters may individually review their rights. Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2001. SENATE SUMMARY Creates a Voter's Bill of Rights. Provides for display and distribution. Prescribes responsibilities of the supervisors of elections in making the Voter's Bill of Rights available to and viewable by the public.
