Subsections (1) and (6) of section 409.906, 10 11 Florida Statutes, are amended to read: 409.906 Optional Medicaid services. -- Subject to 12 13 specific appropriations, the agency may make payments for 14 services which are optional to the state under Title XIX of 15 the Social Security Act and are furnished by Medicaid 16 providers to recipients who are determined to be eligible on the dates on which the services were provided. Any optional 17 18 service that is provided shall be provided only when medically 19 necessary and in accordance with state and federal law. 20 Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent or limit the agency from adjusting fees, reimbursement rates, lengths 21 22 of stay, number of visits, or number of services, or making 23 any other adjustments necessary to comply with the availability of moneys and any limitations or directions 24 25 provided for in the General Appropriations Act or chapter 216. 26 If necessary to safeguard the state's systems of providing 27 services to elderly and disabled persons and subject to the notice and review provisions of s. 216.177, the Governor may 28 29 direct the Agency for Health Care Administration to amend the

Medicaid state plan to delete the optional Medicaid service

known as "Intermediate Care Facilities for the Developmentally Disabled." Optional services may include:

- (1) ADULT DENTURE SERVICES.--The agency may pay for dentures, the procedures required to seat dentures, and the repair and reline of dentures, provided by or under the direction of a licensed dentist, for a recipient who is age 21 or older. However, Medicaid will not provide reimbursement for dental services provided in a mobile dental unit, except for a mobile dental unit:
- (a) Owned or operated by the Department of Health, in compliance with the Medicaid County Health Department Clinic Services program specifications as a County Health Department provider.
- (b) Owned or operated by or under contract with a

 Federally Qualified Health Center, in compliance with the

 Medicaid Federally Qualified Health Center specifications as a

 Federally Qualified Health Center provider.
- (c) That provides dental services to Medicaid recipients, age 21 and over, at a nursing facility.
- (6) CHILDREN'S DENTAL SERVICES.—The agency may pay for diagnostic, preventive, or corrective procedures, including orthodontia in severe cases, provided to a recipient under age 21, by or under the supervision of a licensed dentist. Services provided under this program include treatment of the teeth and associated structures of the oral cavity, as well as treatment of disease, injury, or impairment that may affect the oral or general health of the individual. However, Medicaid will not provide reimbursement for dental services provided in a mobile dental unit, except for a mobile dental unit:

1	(a) Owned or operated by the Department of Health, in

3	Services program specifications as a County Health Department
4	provider.
5	(b) Owned or operated by or under contract with a
6	Federally Qualified Health Center, in compliance with the
