24-1533-01 See HB 1 Senate Resolution No. A resolution honoring Dr. William Russell Mote. 2 3 4 WHEREAS, born in 1906 in Tampa, Florida, Dr. William 5 Russell Mote grew up by the sea and developed an intense love б for all the treasures that it holds, and 7 WHEREAS, Dr. Mote left his home in 1929 for New York, 8 where he founded the Republic Carloading and Distributing Company with partner Ted Bartels, popularizing a technique 9 that made it practical to transport large trailers and 10 11 containers on train flatcars across the United States, and 12 WHEREAS, although he made his fortune developing efficient means of moving cargo from ship to shore, Dr. 13 14 William Mote never forgot his love for the sea, and focused 15 much of his energy and his fortune to protecting the vast 16 riches it held, and 17 WHEREAS, upon his retirement from the Republic 18 Carloading and Distributing Company's Board of Directors, Dr. 19 Mote directed his focus on his first love, serving on The Florida Council of 100 Committee on Oceanography and, after 20 moving to Sarasota, Florida, in 1965, working to make Cape 21 22 Haze Marine Laboratory a thriving marine research facility, 23 and WHEREAS, for his efforts in transforming the small Cape 24 25 Haze Marine laboratory into an internationally recognized 26 institution, the name was changed to Mote Marine Laboratory in 27 1967, in honor of the members of the Mote family, the laboratory's main benefactors, and the following year, Dr. 28 William Mote received the Gold Medal Award of the 29 International Oceanographic Foundation, and 30 31 1
