21-1439-01 1 Senate Resolution No. A resolution recognizing June 2001 as Prostate 2 3 Cancer Awareness Month. 4 5 WHEREAS, prostate cancer is the most common type of 6 cancer among men in the United States and in Florida, and the 7 second leading cause of cancer death among men, and 8 WHEREAS, more than 180,000 men in the United States are 9 diagnosed with prostate cancer each year, and approximately 14,000 of them are residents of Florida, and 10 11 WHEREAS, over 41,000 men in the United States die each 12 year from prostate cancer, and approximately 2,400 of them are 13 residents of Florida, and 14 WHEREAS, men who are members of a racial minority have 15 a 50 percent higher risk of being diagnosed with prostate 16 cancer and are more than twice as likely to die from the 17 disease, and 18 WHEREAS, Florida has the second-highest number of 19 prostate cancer cases and deaths in the United States, and 20 WHEREAS, June is a month in which we commemorate men by the observance of Father's Day and of National Men's Health 21 22 Week, NOW, THEREFORE, 23 24 Be It Resolved by the Senate of the State of Florida: 25 26 That the Florida Senate recognizes June 2001 as 27 Prostate Cancer Awareness Month in Florida and urges all men, 28 and particularly members of high-risk populations, to become 29 aware of the risks and symptoms associated with prostate cancer and to be informed about screening tests, methods for 30 early detection, and treatment. 31
