(3)(a) Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 948.03, only those persons who are convicted and sentenced in circuit court to a cumulative sentence of incarceration for 1 year or more, whether sentence is imposed in the same or separate circuits, may be received by the department into the state correctional system. Such persons shall be delivered to the custody of the department at such reception and classification

centers as shall be provided for this purpose.

(b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a), any prisoner incarcerated in the state correctional system who is convicted in circuit or county court of a crime committed during that incarceration shall serve the sentence imposed for that crime within the state correctional system regardless of the length of sentence or classification of the offense, and the sentence

shall be served consecutive to any sentence previously imposed on the prisoner. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001. SENATE SUMMARY Provides that a prisoner who is sentenced for a crime committed while incarcerated in the state correctional system be required to serve the sentence for that crime in the state system, regardless of the length of sentence imposed or the classification of the offense. Requires that the sentence be served consecutive to any sentence previously imposed on the prisoner.
