I. Summary:

The Division of Statutory Revision of the Office of Legislative Services is required, by statute, to conduct a systematic and continuing study of the Florida Statutes. The purpose of this study is to recommend to the Legislature changes that will remove inconsistencies, redundancies, and unnecessary repetition from the statutes; improve clarity and facilitate correct interpretation; correct grammatical and typographical errors; and delete obsolete, repealed, or superseded provisions. These recommendations are submitted to the Legislature in the form of technical, nonsubstantive reviser's bills.

This is a general reviser's bill, covering volume 3 of the Florida Statutes, to delete expired or obsolete language; correct cross-references and grammatical or typographical errors; remove inconsistencies and redundancies from the statutes; improve the clarity of the statutes and facilitate their correct interpretation; and confirm the restoration of provisions unintentionally omitted from republication in the acts of the Legislature during the amendatory process. A reviser's bill cannot be amended except to delete a bill section.

This bill amends or repeals the following sections of the Florida Statutes: amends ss. 370.0603, 370.092, 370.093, 370.12, 372.5712, 372.5715, 373.4135, 375.021, 376.30713, 377.703, 380.012, 380.0555, 381.003, 381.004, 381.0065, 381.0303, 381.90, 383.50, 384.29, 393.0641, 394.875, 395.0163, 395.3036, 395.4045, 395.602, 395.7015, 400.0091, 400.022, 400.023, 400.141, 400.408, 400.464, 400.980, 402.166, 402.28, 402.50, 403.031, 403.714, 403.718, 403.7191, 403.7192, 408.02, 408.0361, 409.145, 409.1685, 409.908, 409.912, 409.946, 414.105, 418.302, 420.506, 420.507, 435.03, 435.05, 435.07, 440.15, 440.381, 440.4416, 443.1715, 443.232, 445.024, 446.50, 456.025, 456.039, 458.3135, 458.319, and 460.403; and repeals ss. 373.4593(2)(a)-(c), 377.709(5)(b), 381.0045(3), 383.0112(2)(g), 403.854(2)(b), 411.01(9)(c),

421.37, 421.38, 421.39, 421.40, 421.41, 421.42, 421.43, 421.44, 421.45, 427.0159(2), and 464.0045.

General reviser's bills to clean up obsolete language, update cross-references, and correct grammatical and typographical errors and the like are submitted every year.

VIII. Amendments:

#1 by Rules & Calendar:

This amendment removes from the reviser's bill the deletion of s.377.709(5)(b), F.S. The paragraph scheduled for deletion relates to encouragement of parties to review contracts regarding purchase of energy by electric utilities from solid waste management facilities in effect as of 10/1/88, for specified purposes. It is being deleted because it is continuing in effect. (WITH TITLE AMENDMENT)

#2 by Rules & Calendar:

This amendment removes from the reviser's bill the amendment to s.395.3036(2), F.S. The removed provision would ratify a numerical cross-reference update made editorially by the reviser. The section is currently the subject of two lawsuits, and it is being deleted because any change to the text, even if to correct an error, could possibly complicate litigation issues. (WITH TITLE AMENDMENT)

#3 by Rules & Calendar:

This amendment removes from the reviser's bill the deletion of s.403.854(2)(b), F.S. The paragraph scheduled for deletion states that proposed additions to existing treatment plants not under contract for construction as of 7/1/1977, are not automatically exempt from specified requirements. It is being deleted because the language is continuing in nature and still in use. (WITH TITLE AMENDMENT)

#4 by Rules & Calendar:

This amendment removes from the reviser's bill the amendment tos. 443.232,F.S. The removed provision would update a numerical cross-reference in a section relating to rulemaking by the Division of Unemployment Compensation. It is being removed because the whole section needs substantive updating. The division no longer even makes these rules; it is now done by the Agency for Workforce Innovation (WITH TITLE AMENDMENT)
