Participation in the program is a parental option. The Florida Partnership for School Readiness shall 24 25 take into consideration the cost incurred by the state and 26 make its recommendations based on a phase-in plan with 27 emphasis on 4-year old children living in Title I zone 28 neighborhoods and children for whom English is not the primary 29 language. The Florida Partnership for School Readiness shall 30 report its recommendations to the Legislature by November 1, 2001. 31
