Funds shall be credited to the trust fund as provided 24 25 in this part, to be used for the purposes of this part. The trust fund is exempt from the service charges imposed by s. 26 27 215.20. 28 (2) The Public Employee Optional Retirement Program 29 Trust Fund is a retirement trust fund of the Florida 30 Retirement System which accounts for retirement plan assets held by the state in a trustee capacity as a fiduciary for

individual participants in the Public Employee Optional Retirement Program and is not subject to termination under s. 19(f), Art. III of the State Constitution. Section 2.
