prior to the time it is earned and credited to the employee. 1 2 However, each member of the instructional staff and each other 3 employee is shall be entitled to earn no more than 1 day of 4 sick leave times the number of months of employment during the year of employment. If the employee terminates his or her 5 6 employment and has not accrued the 4 sick days of sick leave 7 available to him or her, the district school board may withhold the average daily amount for the days of sick leave 8 9 used days utilized but unearned by the employee. Such leave 10 may shall be taken only when necessary because of sickness as herein prescribed in this section. The sick leave shall be 11 12 cumulative from year to year. A district school board may establish policies and prescribe standards to permit an employee to be absent 6 days 18 each school year for personal reasons. However, such absences 19 for personal reasons must shall be charged only to accrued 20 21 sick leave, and leave for personal reasons is shall be

District school boards may adopt rules permitting 23 24 the annual payment for accumulated sick leave that is earned for that year and that is unused at the end of the school 25 26 year, based on the daily rate of pay of the employee 27 multiplied by up to 80 percent. Days for which such payment 28 is received shall be deducted from the accumulated leave balance. Such annual payment may apply only to instructional 29 30 staff and educational support employees.
