32-484-01 A bill to be entitled An act relating to hunting; prohibiting the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission from sponsoring or conducting, or setting aside special days for, hunting by youths under a certain age in any wildlife management area; providing an effective date. Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: Section 1. The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission may not sponsor or conduct, or set aside special days for, hunting by youths under the age of 16 years in any area designated by the commission as a wildlife management area, notwithstanding that such youths are required to be accompanied by adults while so hunting.
