However, any such 23 firefighter or state law enforcement officer shall have 24 25 successfully passed a physical examination upon entering into 26 any such service as a firefighter or state law enforcement 27 officer, which examination failed to reveal any evidence of 28 any such condition. Such presumption shall not apply to benefits payable under or granted in a policy of life 29 30 insurance or disability insurance, unless the insurer and 31

4	above governmental entities to negotiate policy contracts for

7	presumption that any condition or impairment of health of any
8	firefighter, law enforcement officer, or correctional officer
9	caused by tuberculosis, heart disease, or hypertension
10	resulting in total or partial disability or death was
11	accidental and suffered in the line of duty, unless the
12	contrary be shown by competent evidence.
13	Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
