2	liability coverage for all instructional personnel as defined
3	by s. 228.041(9) who are full-time personnel under their
4	district contracts shall be provided by specific
5	appropriations under the General Appropriations Act.
6	(b) Beginning July 1, 2001, educator professional
7	liability coverage shall be extended at cost to all
8	instructional personnel as defined by s. 228.041(9) who are
9	part-time personnel under their district contracts and who
10	choose to participate in the state-provided program.
11	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.

15	Specifies that educator professional liability insurance
16	coverage for all full-time instructional personnel be provided by specific appropriations under the General
17	Appropriations Act to protect teachers from liability for monetary damages in defense of actions resulting from

19	and extends such coverage to part-time instructional personnel at cost.
