A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to compensation of state  
officials; prescribing the salary rate for  
specified state officials; providing an  
expiration date and an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Notwithstanding paragraph 11.13(1)(b),  
Florida Statutes, or any other law, the salary of members of  
the Senate and House of Representatives shall not be as  
calculated according to that paragraph; instead, those members  
shall be paid salary at the rate that existed on June 30,  
2001. In addition, the salary of the Governor, the Lieutenant  
Governor, the members of the Cabinet, and the heads of all  
departments of the executive branch shall be that which  
existed on June 30, 2001.

Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2002,  
and expires June 30, 2002.

STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN  
COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR  
Senate Bill 22-B

Requires that the salary of the Governor, the Lieutenant  
Governor, the members of the Cabinet and agency heads of the  
executive branch remain at the June 30, 2001 levels.
