Any ordinance imposing a surcharge as provided by s. 218.503(5), Florida Statutes, pursuant to s. 26 132, chapter 99-251, Laws of Florida, adopted by a 27 28 municipality is hereby ratified; all acts, proceedings, and 29 enforcement procedures taken in connection with a parking 30 surcharge imposed by such ordinance are ratified, validated, and confirmed; and the surcharge is declared to be legal and 31
