I. Summary:

Senate Bill 1014 raises the felony degree of planting a hoax bomb from a third degree felony to a second degree felony, thereby making the penalty for this offense commensurate with offenses of similar seriousness.

This bill substantially amends the following sections of the Florida Statutes: 790.165; and 921.0022.

II. Present Situation:

Section 790.165, F.S., provides that it is a third degree felony for a person to manufacture, possess, sell, or deliver a hoax bomb (planting a hoax bomb). However, planting a hoax weapon of mass destruction is a second degree felony. s. 790.166. Further, false reporting of a bomb is a second degree felony. ss. 790.163 and 790.64, F.S.

III. Effect of Proposed Changes:

Senate Bill 1014 raises the felony degree of planting a hoax bomb from a third degree felony to a second degree felony, thereby making the penalty for this offense commensurate with offenses of similar seriousness. The second degree felony is ranked in level 7 of the Criminal Punishment Code offense severity ranking chart.
