A bill to be entitled 1 An act relating to Broward County; extending 2 and enlarging the corporate limits of the City 3 of Deerfield Beach and the City of Pompano 4 Beach to include specified unincorporated lands 5 within said corporate limits; providing for a 6 7 referendum; providing an effective date. 8 9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 10 11 Section 1. The legal description for the 12 unincorporated neighborhoods of Bonnie Loch, Tallman Pines, 13 Tedder, and Woodsetter is as follows: 14 15 That portion of Sections 11, 13 and 14 Township 16 48 South, Range 42 East, Broward County, 17 Florida, described as follows: 18 19 BEGINNING at the intersection of the centerline 20 of N.W. 36 Street (Sample Road) with the 21 Easterly right-of-way line of the Seaboard 2.2 Coastline Railroad, being a point on the 23 municipal boundary of the City of Pompano 24 Beach, as described in Chapter 2000-458, Laws 25 of Florida; 26 27 Thence Northeasterly along said municipal 28 boundary and along said Easterly right-of-way 29 line to the North right-of-way line of Sample 30 Road, as described in said Chapter 2000-458, Laws of Florida; 31

4	Westerly right-of-way line of the Seaboard

22	right-of-way line to the centerline of N.E. 36

26	N.E./N.W. 36 Street (Sample Road) to the POINT
27	OF BEGINNING.

29	Section 2. An election shall be scheduled by the Board
30	of County Commissioners of Broward County in accordance with
31	the provisions of law relating to elections currently in force
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in Broward County on November 5, 2002. Only registered voters 1 2 residing in the unincorporated area as described in section 1 may vote in said election. A mail ballot shall not be used in 3 4 said election. 5 Section 3. The municipality receiving the majority of 6 votes in the election as described in section 2 shall have all 7 powers and responsibilities as provided in section 171.062, 8 Florida Statutes, except as provided in this act as of the 9 effective dates of annexation. 10 Section 4. Upon annexation into a municipality, the 11 following shall govern the areas described in section 1, as 12 provided in this act: for any use, building, or structure that 13 is legally in existence at the time a portion of the area 14 described in section 1 becomes a part of a municipality, such use shall not be made a prohibited use by the municipality, on 15 16 the property of said use, for as long as the use shall continue and is not voluntarily abandoned. 17 Section 5. Subsequent to the effective date of this 18 19 act, no change in land use designation or zoning shall be 20 effective within the limits of the lands subject to annexation herein, until said portion of the areas described in section 1 21 22 has been annexed into a municipality, pursuant to this act. Section 6. All public roads and the public 23 rights-of-way associated therewith, lying within the limits of 24 the lands subject to annexation herein, as described in 25 26 section 1, are transferred from Broward County jurisdiction to 27 the jurisdiction of the annexing municipality. 28 Section 7. The legal description for the Pompano Beach 29 Highlands is as follows: 30 31

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1 right-of-way line of the Florida East Coast 2 Railway; 3 4 THENCE Northeasterly along said East 5 right-of-way line, a portion of which is along the municipal boundary of the City of Deerfield б 7 Beach, as established by Chapter 99-471, Laws 8 of Florida, to the South line of Parcel "A", 9 MORGAN PLAT NO. 1, according to the plat thereof as recorded in Plat Book 110, Page 42, 10 11 of the Public Records of Broward County, 12 Florida; 13 14 THENCE along the municipal boundary of the City 15 of Deerfield Beach, as established by Ordinance 16 1985/24, City of Deerfield Beach, the following 17 two (2) courses; 18 THENCE Easterly along the said South line of 19 20 Parcel "A" to the East line of said Parcel "A"; 21 22 THENCE Northerly along said East line to the intersection with the East right-of-way line of 23 24 N E 13th Way, as shown on said MORGAN PLAT NO. 25 1; 26 27 THENCE along the municipal boundary of the City 28 of Deerfield Beach, as established by Chapter 99-471, Laws of Florida, the following three 29 (3) cou<u>rses;</u> 30 31

17	Section 8. An election shall be scheduled by the Board
18	of County Commissioners of Broward County in accordance with
19	the provisions of law relating to elections currently in force
20	in Broward County on November 5, 2002. Only registered voters
21	residing in the unincorporated area as described in section $7$
22	may vote in said election. A mail ballot shall not be used in
23	said election.
24	Section 9. The municipality receiving the majority of
25	votes in the election as described in section 8 shall have all
26	powers and responsibilities as provided in section 171.062,
27	Florida Statutes, except as provided in this act as of the
28	effective dates of annexation.
29	Section 10. Upon annexation into a municipality, the
30	following shall govern the areas described in section 7, as
31	provided in this act: for any use, building, or structure that
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is legally in existence at the time a portion of the area 1 2 described in section 7 becomes a part of a municipality, such use shall not be made a prohibited use by the municipality, on 3 the property of said use, for as long as the use shall 4 5 continue and is not voluntarily abandoned. 6 Section 11. Subsequent to the effective date of this 7 act, no change in land use designation or zoning shall be 8 effective within the limits of the lands subject to annexation 9 herein, until said portion of the areas described in section 7 has been annexed into a municipality, pursuant to this act. 10 Section 12. All public roads and the public 11 12 rights-of-way associated therewith, lying within the limits of 13 the lands subject to annexation herein, as described in 14 section 7, are transferred from Broward County jurisdiction to the jurisdiction of the annexing municipality. 15 16 Section 13. The legal description for the unincorporated neighborhoods of Kendall Green, Leisureville, 17 and Loch Lomond are as follows: 18 19 20 BEGINNING at the intersection of the Easterly right-of-way line of the Florida East Coast 21 22 Railway as described in Ordinance No. 80-38 of the City Commission of the City of Pompano 23 24 Beach with the South right-of-way line of N.E. 24 Street (Copans Road), as described in said 25 26 Ordinance No. 80-38; 27 28 Thence Northwesterly and Westerly along said 29 South right-of-way line and along the municipal boundary of the City of Pompano Beach, as 30 31 described in said Ordinance No. 80-38, through 7

20	boundary of the City of Pompano Beach, as
21	described in Chapter 2000-458, Laws of Florida,
22	to the Westerly right-of-way line of Interstate
23	95 (State Road No. 9) as shown on Florida
24	Department of Transportation Right-of-way Map
25	(Section 86070-2413);

27	Thence North 88°30'27" East along said Westerly
28	right-of-way line and the South line of a
29	parcel described in Ordinance No. 90-53 of the
30	City Commission of the City of Pompano Beach,

16	an arc distance of 191.25 feet to the North
17	line of the Southwest One-Quarter (SW $1/4$ ) of
18	said Section 23;

21	distance of 1242.61 feet to the East line of
22	the West One-Half (W 1/2) of the Northwest
23	One-Quarter (NW 1/4) of said Section 23;

27	the South One-Half (W 1/2) of the Northwest

Only registered 11 12 voters residing in the unincorporated area as described in 13 section 13 may vote in said election. A mail ballot shall not 14 be used in said election. 15 Section 15. The municipality receiving the majority of 16 votes in the election as described in section 14 shall have all powers and responsibilities as provided in section 17 171.062, Florida Statutes, except as provided in this act as 18 19 of the effective dates of annexation. 20 Section 16. Upon annexation into a municipality, the following shall govern the areas described in section 13, as 21 provided in this act: for any use, building, or structure that 22 is legally in existence at the time a portion of the area 23 24 described in section 13 becomes a part of a municipality, such 25 use shall not be made a prohibited use by the municipality, on 26 the property of said use, for as long as the use shall 27 continue and is not voluntarily abandoned. 28 Section 17. Subsequent to the effective date of this 29 act, no change in land use designation or zoning shall be effective within the limits of the lands subject to annexation 30 31

herein, until said portion of the areas described in section 13 has been annexed into a municipality, pursuant to this act. Section 18. All public roads and the public rights-of-way associated therewith, lying within the limits of the lands subject to annexation herein, as described in section 13, are transferred from Broward County jurisdiction to the jurisdiction of the annexing municipality. Section 19. This act shall take precedence over any other enacted law. Section 20. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
